



Dummy Roping Rules and Procedures

JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL

- * Contestants must be no older than 12 years old on the date of the event.
- * The event will be limited to 24 contestants.
- * Contestants must be checked-in at Wednesday, April 20th, 2022 Check-in by 5:45 PM at Echo Valley Ranch, 205 Nevada St, Auburn 95603
- * After assessing the contestants, they will all be placed in 4 different divisions based on their roping ability. At that time, they will compete against the other children in their division for prizes.

ROUND 1

- * All contestants will get **3 attempts** to rope the dummy.
- * The contestant must stand behind a line on the ground while roping or they will be disqualified.
- * The contestant must allow the loop to completely leave their hand before it touches the dummy in order for points to be awarded.

Points awarded per attempt:

| | |
|-------------|----------|
| Slick horns | 3 points |
| Neck | 2 points |
| Half-head | 1 point |

All other catches will be **0 points**.

*If there is a tie after 1 round, we will go on to round 2

ROUND 2

The dummy will be moved out and each remaining contestant will get 3 more loops and points will be awarded on the same scale as in ROUND 1.

*If there is a tie after ROUND 2, we will go on to ROUND 3

ROUND 3

The dummy will be moved forward after each loop in a sudden death format until there is a winner.

PRIZES

All contestants will win prizes for participating. The 1st through 3rd place contestant in each division will win additional prizes. There will not be buckles at the event this year, but there will be many other comparable trophy awards.
